Antrim and Newtownabbey Borough Council is the Data Controller under Data Protection legislation and will use the information that you provide for the purposes of processing your request for access to support. Antrim and Newtownabbey Borough Council will not share or disclose your personal data to any other organisation without your consent or unless the law places an obligation on the council to do so. Information will not be transferred outside the EEA. All information collected and processed may be subject to audit. The Council may also process the information for research purposes carried out in the public interest.

Personal data is held and stored by Antrim and Newtownabbey Borough Council in a safe and secure manner and in compliance with Data Protection legislation.
